



The Florida United Methodist Foundation provides two loan programs for United Methodist students.
Please check the one for which you are applying.

- Campbell Trust:** Campbell Trust student loans are available to any full-time student attending a junior or senior college, university or seminary, or other institution for educational or occupational training beyond high school. Consideration of applicants is given in the following order:
 - Florida residents attending United Methodist-affiliated institutions in Florida.
 - Florida residents attending United Methodist-affiliated institutions outside Florida.
 - Florida residents attending non-church-related institutions.
 - Non-Florida residents attending church-related institutions.
- Hilburn Prine:** Hilburn Prine student loans are available to students pursuing a degree or certificate in a Christian education field. This may include pastors, directors of Christian education, children and youth counselors, teachers, youth coordinators, and children and youth directors associated with Christian schools, local after-school programs or camping ministries. Applicants must be full-time students attending a junior or senior college, university or seminary, or other institution of higher education beyond high school.

LOAN PROGRAM CRITERIA

1. Applicants must be full and active members of a United Methodist church within the Florida Conference and admitted to a degree program at an accredited institution within the United States.
2. Applicants may apply and receive loans for fall and spring terms. **Applications are received July 1-31.**
3. All loans must be co-signed, and all loan applications must include a signature sheet signed by the applicant and co-signer. Once a loan is awarded, a promissory note signed by the borrower and a cosigner legally binds them to the repayment terms as specified in the note.
4. Loans are repayable after graduation or withdrawal from school. The interest rate for student loans is 5 percent.
5. Interest accrues on the principal loan balance from the date the loan check is disbursed and continues until the loan is paid in full. The borrower may repay all or any part of the principal plus accrued interest at any time without penalty.
6. While in school, all loan recipients must submit a verification of enrollment form from the school for each semester they receive funding. The verification forms may be obtained from the foundation by calling 866-363-9673 or emailing foundation@fumf.org.
7. Final payment is due no later than 120 months from the date the first payment is due.
